Results Legend & Recommendations



Positive (Critical): Viral RNA detected for both N1 and N2 genes tested for COVID-19	Recommendation: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Quarantine for 10 days.2. Notify anyone you may have exposed so that they may test.3. Notify all healthcare providers seen on a regular basis.4. Seek medical attention.5. Consider retest after quarantine.
Negative (Normal): Viral RNA not detected for COVID-19	Recommendation: No further action required.
Inconclusive (Abnormal): Presumed Positive. Viral RNA detected from one (1) of the two (2) genes (N1, N2) tested for COVID-19.	Recommendation: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. For inconclusive results, the safest recommendation is for you to re-test until either a positive or negative result occurs and for you to follow the quarantine guidance as if you were considered a presumptive positive until the second test could show otherwise.2. Seek medical attention if you are in any distress.
Invalid (Run Failure):	Internal control failure for repeat runs with the given sample.
